

### PRESS RELEASE



The second edition of the TWS will be held from Tuesday 19 to Saturday 23 March 2019 to the "Anciens Abattoirs" historical building of La Chaux-de-Fonds.

After a first edition in which, for lack of time, we proposed that the exhibitors show their knowledge in their own premises and in view of the popular success, about 1000 visitors met during this one, we decided to put the matter back on the drawing-board and propose again the technical Watchmaking fair TWS, but, this time, on a unique site by hosting the exhibitors in an environment steeped in history and conducive to exchanges. However, exhibitors wishing to show their knowledge in their own premises were also invited to participate in TWS 2019.

This is how we can count, for the 2019 edition, on a panel of 50 exhibitors (Soldout) on the site of the Anciens Abattoirs, to which are added some companies that will exhibit on their premises. On the selected site, exhibitors will establish fertile ground to present their know-how and products. However, due to lack of infrastructure, we had to refuse 8 to 10 exhibitors, having announced late. Needless to say that we will make every effort to give them satisfaction during the 2020 edition, knowing that the site can be expanded as renovations progress.

#### Exhibition venue and 2019 concept

- The exhibition area is located in the old slaughterhouses of La Chaux-de-Fonds dating from 1859 and partially renovated in 2018
